Certified Mediums Biographies:



Reverend Dr. Rosemary Calderalo is an NSAC ordained minister and holds the NSAC credentials of certified medium, commissioned healer and National Spiritualist Teacher. She is a member of the Morris Pratt Institute as well as a member at the Center for Spiritual Enlightenment in Falls Church, Virginia, and is a graduate of the two-year mediumship program at the Inner Spiritual Center, an independent Spiritualist Center in Wayne, NJ. Her focus on healing first brought her to a Spiritualist church in 2006; she has served churches throughout the country and has served internationally as well. Originally from New York City, she now lives in Pasadena, MD.



Reverend Marrice Coverson is the Pastor of the Church of the Spirit in Chicago -- the first female and African American to hold that position. Rev. Coverson is also the first African American since 1924 to hold a Trustee position on the Board of Directors of National Spiritualist Association (NSAC) of Church's Board of Directors. She also has served as President of the NSAC Illinois Chapter. Marrice Coverson is also the Founder of the Institute for Positive Living and the Executive Director of the Open Book Program, a citywide, after-school literacy initiative for adolescents. Ms. Coverson holds a BA in Sociology from Mississippi Valley State University and a MA in Public Administration from Roosevelt University. She has a MA in Theology at the Chicago Theological Seminary.



Reverend Lelia Cutler is the Senior Minister at the Church. Rev Cutler teaches classes in Meditation, Mediumship and a series of classes on Comparative Religion, healing, Symbolism, Spiritual Regression and Biblical Spirituality. She was ordained as a minister in 1988 by the National Spiritualist Association of Churches and has served on the National Board for over 15 years. She also served as a past president of the NSAC.



Reverend Celeste Elliott is an ordained Spiritual minister and medium who lives, works, serves, and plays in Lily Dale, NY. Her attraction to Spiritualism is the philosophy of peace, healing, and growth. Celeste likes to travel via zoom to serve churches in various parts of the United States and Canada whenever possible. When not working Celeste is usually off studying, volunteering, or communing with coffee.



Reverend Lorraine Radice of the Church of Spiritual Growth, NSAC in Burlington, MA, is a long-time member of the National Spiritualist Association of Churches. She is a National Spiritualist Teacher founding member of the Church of Spiritual Growth, its former Pastor and has served as a Board Member and Committee Member at the local and national levels. She lectures and teaches a wide variety of workshops at churches and camps throughout the U.S. With over 30 years of study and experience and having studied under many talented and well-established NSAC Spiritualists, Lorraine, Ordained Minister and a Certified Medium. She is a uses her unique gifts and spiritual insight to inspire the unfoldment and enlightenment of everyone she meets.



Reverend Havivah Richards is Pastor of the Church of the Living Spirit in Phoenix, AZ, which is part of the NSAC (the National Spiritualist Association of Churches). She is an Ordained Minister, NST Teacher, Certified Medium, and Commissioned Healer. She is a Trustee on the National Spiritualist Association of Churches Board and their Director of Lyceums. Havi is a fifth generation Spiritualist who truly loves teaching and helping explain Spiritualism and its aspects to everyone.



Reverend Nancy S Ryall is a Spiritual minister, certified medium, healer, and a Spiritual Missionary ordained from the National Spiritualist Association of Churches (NSAC). She is the current Pastor of JT & EJ Crumbaugh Spiritualist Church in Le Roy, IL, the founding Pastor of Spiritualist Chapel in the Woods in Cherry Valley, IL.
